## **ORDER OF OPERATIONS (PEMDAS) Facts**

## No. Facts about PEMDAS

- 1. Mathematical expressions are worked from <u>LEFT</u> to <u>RIGHT</u> in a particular order that must be adhered to.
- 2. Mathematical expressions are worked from **IN** to **OUT** when there are parenthesis or brackets involved.
- Operations inside parenthesis or brackets are worked first from the most <u>INNER</u> to the most <u>OUTER</u>
- 4. Operations involving exponents are worked from **LEFT** to **RIGHT**
- 5. Multiplication and division operations are worked from <u>LEFT</u> to <u>RIGHT</u> whichever comes first.
- 6. Multiplication is performed before Division if it is the first operation that appears in the mathematical expression from left to right.
- 7. Division is performed before Multiplication if it is the first operation that appears in the mathematical expression from left to right
- 8. Addition and subtraction operations are worked from <u>LEFT</u> to <u>RIGHT</u> whichever comes first.
- 9. Addition is performed before Subtraction if it is the first operation that appears in the mathematical expression from left to right
- 10. Subtraction is performed before Addition if it is the first operation that appears in the mathematical expression from left to right.
